HARLAN - Maud Elizabeth Page, daughter of Amasa and Bertha Jane Fish Page, was born July 18, 1908 at Aster. She attended Manilla School at Manilla and grew to adulthood on a farm in the Manilla area.

March 19, 1927, she married Walter R. Page, Avoca. To this union ten children were born. They made their home in Avoca until 1942. They then lived at Oakland, Minden, Co. Bluffs and Omaha before moving to Harlan in 1949, where she has continued to reside. She died at Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, Dec. 14, 1996, at age 88 years, four months and 26 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Walter, Feb. 1, 1969; her daughter, Betty, and her son, Donald; her grandson, Ricky Lee Page; her granddaughters, Colleen Page and Debra Page; her daughters-in-law, Elaine Page, Jackie Page and Peggy Page; her sister, Belle Pope, and brother, Harry Fish.
