Santa Ana, CA- Nadine Cullison Page, daughter of Judge and Mrs. George W. Cullison was born Nov. 24, 1993, in Harlan. She was the sister of Judge Bennett Cullison, whose wife, Anna May Cullison still resides in the Cullison family home. She attended Grinnell College, and graduated from

the University of Iowa in 1926.

In 1930 she married George Russell Page and moved to Baltimore, MD. She lived there for 32 years before relocating to CA in 1965, following her husband's death. She was active in more than 30 different organizations, often serving as either president of chairperson. She was a member of the PEO Sisterhood, belonging to four different chapters of the organization and serving in all offices. She was also active in the Gamma Phi Betal Sorority for over 60 years, serving as Collegiate Province Director and then International Director of Finance for the sorority. She was listed in the first edition of "Who's Who in American Women" in 1958, and was listed a second time in 1990. Throughout her life, she maintained a deep sense of loyalty to Harlan and always kept up on the town news via the family and the Harlan Tribune. She died Oct. 31, 1993, in Santa Ana, CA at age 89 years, 11 months and 7 days.

Survivors include one son, David (Jo) Page of Long Beach, CA; one daughter, Marcia (Robert) Cooley of Orange, Ca; and three grandchildren. Local survivors include a sister-in-law, Anna May Cullison, and a nephew,

Bennett Cullison, both of Harlan.
