Nov. 9, 1911 - March 28, 1994

Earling - Albert Pauley, son of Hobert and Anna (Mickels) Pauley was born Nov. 9, 1911 on a farm near Panama. He died March 28, 1994 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 82 years, four months and 19 days. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama, and attended rural country school near Portsmouth. He grew to adulthood on his parents farm near Panama.

Nov. 9, 1937 he married Cyrilla Bissen at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling. This union was blessed with four children. After their marriage, they farmed near Panama for six years before moving to a farm near Tennant which they farmed for the next five years. In 1949, they moved to their present farm home near Earling. This has been their home since that time. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling, and is a past member of the Knights of Columbus, Earling Council #1741.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, Fred and Walter Pauley, twin sisters, Martina and Martha Pauley, one grandson, J.R. Gross and a son-in-law, Lee M. Gross.
