Defiance - Gertrude Bertha Pauley, daughter of Julius and Julia (Nowatzke) Wiese was born Feb. 5, 1898 at Portsmouth. She died July 28, 1994 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 96 years, five months and 23 days. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Portsmouth. She attended St. Mary's Catholic school in Portsmouth and grew to adulthood on her parents farm. She worked at home on the farm and one of the things she was in charge of was frying down hogs.

This was her home until Oct. of 1993 when she became a resident of Little Flower Haven in Earling. In addition to her parents, her husband and her son Bernard Jr. (Jim), she was preceded in death by eight brothers - Julius, Michael, Jacob, Paul, Joe, John, Peter and Frank Wiese; and one sister - Rosalia Wiese.
