

Elden Henry Paulsen, 87

ATLANTIC - Elden Henry Paulsen, 87, of Elk Horn, died Friday, June 9, 1990 at Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, where he had been a resident the past 3 1/2 years.

The son of Chris and Sena Gregersen Paulsen, he was born Sept. 6, 1902 in Living Springs near Macedonia in Pottawattamie Co., and moved north of Atlantic at the age of four with his family and then to Atlantic in 1917. Following schooling he moved to a farm in Audubon Co., to help his brother with farming. He married Myrle Estella Nelson Sept. 1, 1928 in Atlantic. They farmed west of Brayton four years, south of Dysart ten years and northeast of Walnut until 1955 when they moved to Elk Horn. He was a member of the Lutheran Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a son, Clint M. Paulsen, Nov. 9, 1980; and four brothers, Orlie, George, Louie and Walter Paulsen. Surviving are his wife, Myrtle of Elk Horn; a daughter, Martys (Charles) Martens of rural Walnut; seven grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; daughter-in-law, Betty Paulsen of Atlantic, and a sister-in-law, Esther Paulsen of Bentonville, AR.
