Omaha, NE - Frances Marguerite Pedersen, the daughter of Archibald and Minta (Robinson) Isom was born April 19, 1904 at Red Oak. At the age of four she moved with her family to Omaha, where they lived for five years. They then lived in Windside, NE, one year before moving back to Omaha, NE. She attended school in Omaha.

Dec. 31, 1928 she married Henry W. Pedersen at Fremont, NE. They continued to make their home in Omaha. To this union two sons were born. She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Omaha, PEO of Omaha and the Douglas County Republican Women. She had been a resident of Little Flower Haven in Earling. She died Dec. 2, 1994 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 90 years, seven months and 13 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Henry. She is survived by her two sons - Dave (Pat) of Harlan, and Donald (Teresa) of Helena, MT; five grandchildren; five great-grandchildren and other relatives.
