ELK HORN — Anna Marie Petersen was born Nov. 27, 1898 in Shelby County. Her parents were Rasmus and Mary (Larsen) Jacobsen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton, was a lifelong member here.

She married Peter R. Petersen on July 17, 1920. They farmed two miles south and ½ mile west of Kimballton in Shelby County. Peter died in 1929. She moved to Kimballton in 1936 where she has lived until recently. She has done housework for many people while living in Kimballton, she has also worked at the Marne-Elk Horn Telephone office and the grocery store. She moved to the Salem Homes in Elk Horn in Sept. 1987 where she died at age 89 on Jan. 20, 1988.
