HARLAN - Glenn E. Petersen, son of Nis and Sena Christensen Petersen was born Sept. 14, 1920, in Jackson Twp., Shelby county, on the same farm he has lived his entire life. He attended Jackson No. 2 School and was a baptized, confirmed and life long member of the Bethlehem Lutheran Church.

In the 40's and 50's, he drove the family owned truck, hauling livestock and grain for area farmers and later he drove for Petersen Brothers. June 7, 1954, he married Mae Ericksen at the Little Brown Church at Nashua. He and his sons were engaged in a farm partnership until he retired in 1985. He was a former member of the Jacksonville Ball Club and the Elk Horn Saddle Club. He was a member of the Shelby County Pork Producers and was Pork Producer of the year in 1982, and was a member of the Community Heritage Society in Kimballton. He died Feb. 20, 1990 at the St. Joseph's Hospital in Omaha at age 69 years, 5 months and 6 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his wife, Mae; two sons, Wayne and Carl; one brother, Raymond L. Petersen, all of rural Harlan; two grandchildren; many nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were Feb. 22, 1990 at the Bethlehem Lutheran Church with Rev. Oliver S. Solberg, officiating. Burial was in the Bethlehem cemetery with Ed Hansen, Jack Claussen, Harvey Leinen, Ernest Petersen, Lester Petersen and LaVerne Koppold serving as casketbearers.
