HARLAN - Clarice Wiemer Peterson, daughter of John and Theodosia (Wiegert) Wiemer, was born Jan. 29, 1915 at Harlan. She attended Harlan High School graduating in 1932.

Feb. 20, 1935, she married Henry H. Peterson in the Methodist Parsonage in Harlan. Four children were born to this union. They continued to live on the family farm until they retired and moved into Harlan in 1984. After the death of her husband April 22, 1994, she continued to reside in her own home in Harlan. She died at the Immanuel Medical Center in Omaha, NE, Oct. 17, 1996, at age 81 years, eight months and 18 days.
