

## Lucille E. Pieper, 92

Nov. 14, 1904 - Dec. 29, 1996 ✓

**MINDEN** - Lucille Elizabeth Pieper was born at Minden Nov. 14, 1904, daughter of Louie and Anna Graves Ehlers and was one of four children in the family. She attended school in Minden and graduated from Minden High School in 1923. She then attended college at Omaha University and graduated with a degree in teaching in 1925. She taught in various schools in the area, was Secretary for the Minden Independent Schools for two years and retired from the Tri-Center School District.

She married Edmund Pieper at Treynor June 6, 1934. While he served with the Army during World War II, she was employed at Camp Callen in San Diego, CA as supervisor of the Maintenance Room. Following the War, they returned to Minden. He died Aug. 12, 1991. She was a member of the Minden United Church of Christ and its Women's Fellowship. She died at her home in Minden Dec. 29, 1996 at age 92 years, 1 month and 15 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Edmund, two sisters; Muree Hinton and Alma Kay and a brother, Clarence Ehlers. She is survived by her nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Jan. 2, 1997 at the Minden United Church of Christ with Rev. Richard Hempenius officiating. Burial was in the Minden cemetery. Casket bearers were: John C.
