## **Lowell R. Plambeck, 67**

**July 12, 1927 - Nov. 2, 1994**

**Persia** - Lowell R. Plambeck was born July 12, 1927 at Persia to Bertha (Legan) Plambeck and William Plambeck Jr. He was raised in the Persia area, was baptized into the Lutheran faith at age 7 and graduated from Persia High School in 1946.

He farmed and drove school bus for the Tri-Center School district for 35 years.
