

Alan Lee Plymale, 39

July 27, 1954 - March 29, 1994

Avoca - Alan Lee Plymale was born at Crestview, FL July 27, 1954, the son of Dale and Delores Southworth Plymale. He was one of four children in the family. He attended school in Omaha and graduated from South High School. He served in the U.S. Army during the Viet Nam War. He returned to Omaha and attended Universal Technical Institute in Omaha, where he studied refrigeration.

He married Roxanne Schueman, June 21, 1986 in Avoca. They made their home in Boulder, CO until they moved to Omaha and then in 1993 they moved to Avoca. He worked as an instructor at UTI for a time and the past 4 1/2 years he has been employed by Sears as a Service Technician. His duties also included being a Certified Refrigerant Recovery Instructor for Sears. He was a member of the Viet Nam Era Veterans and the Refrigerant Service Engineers Society. He died March 29, 1994 as a result of injuries suffered in a car accident near Underwood.

He was preceded in death by his father. He is survived by his wife Roxanne, two children: Alan Plymale, Jr. and Sunshine Plymale, both of Omaha, his mother, Delores Kelley of Boise, ID, one sister: Toni (Keith) Helmrich of Arvada, CO, two brothers; LeRoy Plymale of Omaha and Rick Plymale (Monica) of Winder, GA, besides other relatives.

Funeral services were held April 1, 1994 at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca with Pastor Keith Sievers and Mr. Wayne Paulsen, Lay Assistant officiating.
