FORT DODGE – Eileen Anna Hilbert was born March 23, 1927, on a farm near Irwin. In 1936, she moved with her parents into Irwin where she later graduated from Irwin High School in 1945.

In 1945, she married Harold Pace in Irwin. Following their marriage they lived in Irwin, later moving to Glidden, Denison, and finally to Fort Dodge in 1960. She was a homemaker. She died Dec. 15, 1999, at the Fort Dodge Villa Cottages at age 72.
