PANAMA - Zeno Matthew Pauley, son of Hobart and Anna (Mickels) Pauley, was born March 14, 1906, near Panama. He was the second child of 11 born to Mr. and Mrs. Pauley. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama and also attended St. Mary's Catholic School also in Panama. He spent most of his life on the family farm near Panama with his parents. After the death of his father, he purchased a house in Panama in April of 1962, making a home for his mother until her death in 1968. April 27, 1992, he became a resident of Rose Vista Home in Woodbine. It was there that he died May 25, 1998, at age 92 years, two months and 11 days.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers, Leo, Fritz, Albert and Walter; his twin sisters, Martina and Martha; his sister-in-law, Louise Pauley; his brothers-in-law, S. H. Bud Weis and Nicholas Schmitz.
