MO. VALLEY - Consuela Cora (Connie) Plummer Perkins, age 85, of Missouri Valley, died Aug. 1, 1999, at the Community Memorial Hospital in Missouri Valley. She was born March 11, 1914, in Logan, to Caleb William (Cale) and Mary Ellen (Ella) Marshall Plummer.
