**OMAHA** - Marilyn Ruth Piper was born Aug. 9, 1929, at Schuyler, NE to Roy and Ruth Irene Knauss Piper. At age 5 she moved with her parents to Irwin where she graduated in 1947. She graduated from Immanuel Hospital School of Nursing Aug. 6, 1950. She began working at the Veterans Hospital in Omaha, retiring in May 1986 after 34 years. After serving 2 years in the U.S. Air Force at Lackland AFB in Texas, she returned to work full time at the VA Hospital in March 1961. She belonged to the Nebraska Air National Guard until her discharge in 1967.

She was a member of the First Christian Church in Omaha. She died May 26, 1998, at the Lutheran Home in Omaha, at age 68.
