Dr. Judson Thompson, 75 *1960*

Feb. 15, 1917 — Dec. 20, 1992

Dr. Judson A. Thompson, son of Lawrence and Esther (Christensen) Thompson, was born Feb. 15, 1917 in Storden, MN.

He was a veteran of WW II, serving as a captain in the Veterinary Corps. He was in large animal practice then with the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture. Upon retirement in 1974, he resumed his farming interests, moving to their farm east of Nevada, MO. He moved to Chino Valley in 1985. He died Dec. 20, 1992 at his home in Chino Valley. He was a former Harlan resident.

He is survived by his wife, Loyce Thompson of Chino Valley; two daughters, Carolyn Mainguene of Bartlett, IL., and Kathryn Alyson of Fremont, CA.; two sisters; three brothers; and one grandson.
