March 21, 1933 - June 2, 1997

CARSON - Marilyn Jo Todd was one of nine children born to Erroll O. and Mary E. (Horn) Berney. She was born March 21, 1933 at Wolbach, NE. She attended Wolbach School and graduated with the class of 1951, where she was Wolbach High School's first homecoming queen.

She married Ray W. Scheibe at Junction City, KS, July 17, 1951. She taught school for one year near Wolbach. Their marriage was blessed with the birth of a daughter, Teri. He joined the U.S. Army and was killed in action in Korea in 1953.

She married William Raleigh Todd at Plattsmouth, NE, Feb. 3, 1956. Their marriage was blessed with a daughter, Cheryl, and sons, William, Alan and Tim. He died in 1982 and she continued to live in Carson. She worked in the Carson office of Don Smith Insurance and was a member of the Carson Presbyterian Church, the B & W Club and the Carson American Legion Auxiliary. She died from cancer at her home June 2, 1997, at age 64 years, two months and 11 days.
