

Zella M. Terrill, 100

HARLAN—Zella Mae Terrill was born to Cora Bell (Knouse) and John M. Bamsey at Harlan, Sept. 19, 1901. She attended country school in rural Harlan.

Feb. 26, 1920, she married Elliott A. Terrill. To this union seven children were born. Zella lived in Harlan her entire life. She was a housewife and mother who cleaned homes in the Harlan area. She was a member of the United Methodist Church in Harlan. She died May 5, 2002, at Little Flower Haven Nursing and Rehab Center at age 100 years, seven months and 16 days.
