

## Mildred M. Vogelzang, 73

**HARLAN** – Mildred Mary Vogelzang was born Nov. 27, 1927, to Anna (Golhofer) and John Schoenherr in Mapleton. She was baptized and confirmed at the Catholic Church in Mapleton and attended Mapleton Catholic School through the eighth grade.
