She has lived for the last 21 years with her brother Gordon. She has been most of that time a constant and patient sufferer. She passed away December 25, 1936. Three brothers and two sisters have preceded her in death. Three brothers and two sisters survive her and a number of nieces and nephews and a host of friends. She was christened in the Scotch Presbyterian church.
