Harry Athas, 60, of Cumming, formerly of Des Moines, died of a heart ailment Monday at Iowa Methodist hospital following a one-day illness.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday at St. George Greek Orthodox church where he was a member. Burial will be in the cemetery at Orillia.

Born in Greece, Mr. Athas, a resident of Cumming 20 years, had been a farm operator. He previously lived in Des Moines where he owned and operated the Liberty Lunch at 622 Mulberry St. He was a member of the Scottish Rites Masonic Lodge, Order of Ahepa, of Norwalk.

He is survived by a brother, Alexander of Des Moines.
