

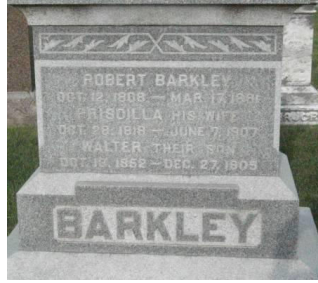

In the matter of the estate of
Walter Barkley, deceased

Comes now Thomas Barkley, the duly appointed and legally qualified administrator in the above and foregoing estate and represents to the Court that said estate is perfectly solvent and that there are funds on hands, after allowing everything, over \$2,000.00 as shown by the six months report duly made and filed herein as provided by law; that the only heir at law of the said deceased is his mother who now resides in the property left by the deceased and that it is very desirable on the part of the only heir, the said mother of the said deceased, and all parties concerned, that the house be painted and that barn on said premises have a roof placed thereon for the reason that the old roof is now rotted and decayed and does not keep out the weather from said premises; and that the granary also requires a new roof in order to protect same; that all parties interested and concerned are desirous to repair said real estate in the manner indicated in this application.

WHEREFORE, Your petitioner asks this order from the court empowering and authorizing him to use part of the sums now on hands to the extent of \$150.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary to make said repairs and to report the amount so consumed and used to this Court in the manner and form provided by law.

On October 6, 1906 the order was given and repairs were made.

Application for Order for Monument

Comes now Thomas Barkley, the duly appointed and legally qualified administrator in the above and foregoing estate and represents to the Court that said estate is perfectly solvent and that the only heir-at-law of said estate is the deceased mother, Priscilla Barkley; that the said heir together with the brothers and sisters of the deceased are desirous that a suitable and proper monument be placed at the grave of the deceased; that the expense thereof to be charged to the said estate herein is Three Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$375.00); that said sum is a suitable amount to pay for said monument and will leave the estate perfectly solvent to pay all debts filed and allowed against said estate.

WHEREFORE, The administrator herein, Thomas Barkley asks an order from this Court authorizing, empowering and directing him to place a suitable monument at the grave of the deceased and charge same to the estate herein. Said sum not to exceed the sum of Three Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$375.00).

There was a sale of livestock, machinery and household goods.
The estate was completed on September 27, 1907

His living relatives were his mother, Priscilla Barkley, age 87; his sister Armeda Lockridge, age 43; and his brother Thomas, age 63; all living at Orilla, Iowa.

For a complete report of the Walter Barkley Estate it can be seen on Estate No. 2259 on file at Indianola, Iowa. It was quite a lengthy estate.
