Died in Des Moines, Sunday, Feb. 18, 1906, Mr. N. F. Day of Orillia, at the Methodist Hospital. Aged 52 years.

Mr. Day has been at the hospital for some time, being troubled with cancer of the stomach. He leaves a wife and five children. The funeral will be held from the Orilla church Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock.
