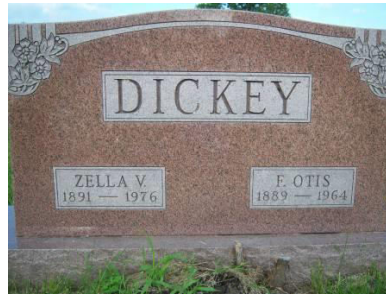

Frank Otis Dickey, 75, of Mitchellville died Friday morning at Iowa Methodist Hospital after a four month illness following a paralytic stroke.

Services will be at 2:30 p.m. Sunday at McLaren's Funeral Home. Burial will be at Orilla Cemetery.

Mr. Dickey was born in Warren County and was a farmer in the Johnston Station and Orilla areas before retiring 10 years ago.

Surviving are his wife, Zella; two sons, Floyd of Des Moines and Wayne of Runnells; daughter, Mrs. Winifred Higgins of Grimes; sister, Mrs. Lerina Westberg of Des Moines; eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
