On last Saturday morning occurred the death of little Grant Hanson, only son of Carl and Martha Hanson. He was taken sick on Monday with a sore throat and later developed into membranous croup. The medical care and all that kind and loving hands could do was of no avail, and today he "is not dead, but sleeping." Grant was 6 years and 4 months old, he was a bright, happy boy, idolized by his parents and loved by all; the sorrowing father and mother have the sympathy of the whole community in this great affliction. It made it more sad that owing to the contagious character of the disease, those friends that would gladly have gone to comfort and help them, could not go. The funeral services were held at the house on Monday and he was laid to rest in the Pleasant Ridge cemetery.
