Services for William S. Haynes, 57, of 129 Franklin Ave., will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Community Church in Cumming. Burial will be at Orillia.

Mr. Haynes, an employee at the Des Moines Steel Co. for 17 years, died of cancer Friday at Iowa Methodist Hospital. Born in Cumming, he had lived in Des Moines 24 years. He was a member of the Cumming Community Church.
