The funeral services of Mrs. Finley Hull who died of heart disease at Denison, Texas, were held at the Pleasant Ridge church Monday of last week. Her aged father and several

brothers and sisters came to attend the funeral. Deceased was known to many here as Ella Ware and for several years after her marriage lived in the community. She was a noble Christian woman; the husband and two little children have the sympathy of a large friendship; she was laid to rest in a grave draped in white and covered with flowers by loving hands.
