Mrs. Miller died Friday morning at Madison County Memorial Hospital in Winterset of complications resulting from a broken hip she had suffered 9 weeks ago.

She was born at Churchville and had lived in Winterset 11 years and 30 years in California. She was a member of the Methodist Church.

Survivors include a sister, Mrs. Lena Rusk, of Hill City, Minnesota; and two brothers, William Russ of Long Beach, California and Louis Russ of Winterset.
