Charles W. Misner, pioneer grocery merchant of Polk County, died suddenly early Tuesday at his home, 1123 Polk Boulevard. He was 72.

He had been a resident of Iowa for sixty years, coming to this state from Virginia. He settled at Cumming, Iowa. He came to Des Moines nineteen years ago.

He was a member of the Modern Woodsman of America. In addition to his widow, he is survived by a daughter, Ada B. Misner, and a son J. H. Misner, both of Des Moines.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Thursday at Harbach's Funeral Home. Burial will be in Orillia, Iowa.
