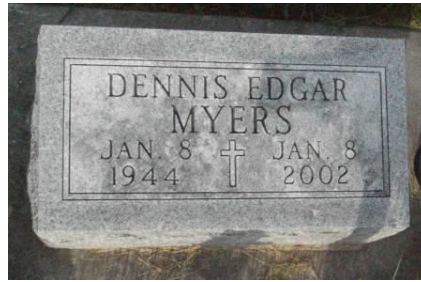

Dennis E. Myers, 58, of the 100 block of Northwest State Street, Ankeny, died of cancer Tuesday at Hospice Kavanagh House. Services will be at 11 a.m. Friday at Hamilton's Funeral Home, with burial at Pleasant Ridge Cemetery in Orilla.

Mr. Myers was born in Staten Island, N. Y. and had lived in the Des Moines area most of his life. He had lived in Ankeny since 1985. He had worked for Bridgestone-Firestone Tire Co.,

where he had prepped tires in the little curing department, before retiring after 32 years. He most recently had worked for Wal-Mart in Ankeny and was a member of United Steelworkers Local 310 Retirees. He was an avid Chicago Bears fan and enjoyed golfing, auto racing and camping.
