**HARLAN** - Janice Cleone Dickinson, daughter of Clarence and Frances Kraus Flanagan was born Aug. 26, 1940, at Overbrook, KS. She was raised in Topeka and graduated from Highland Park High School in 1958. In December of 1964, she married Robert G. Dickinson at Topeka and to this union four children were born. They lived in Harlan until 1987 where he was employed at Harlan Manufacturing. They returned to Topeka until this past fall when they moved back to this area.
