OSAGE - Craig Doll, 43 of Osage died May 11, 1990 at Mitchell Co. Memorial Hospital, Osage, of Cancer. He was born March 19, 1947 at Co. Bluffs, the son of Edwin and Ethel (Karstens) Doll. He grew up in Avoca and graduated from Avoca High School in 1965. He graduated from Iowa State University in 1969 and the University of Iowa College of Law in 1972.

He married Ellen Blair, Aug. 31, 1969 at Irwin. They moved to Osage in 1972 where he was associated with the Law Firm of Casey, Doll & Cross. He was a member of the American Bar Association and the Iowa State Bar Association, the Association For Retarded Citizens, Osage Kiwanis and was a former president. He served with the J.A.G. corps of the U.S. Army reserve. In 1980 he traveled to Manchester, England as a member of a Rotary Group Study Exchange Team. He was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church.

He was preceded in death by an infant son, John Michael and his mother, Ethel.
