

Gaillard D. Dickinson, 80

Aug. 4, 1919 – Aug. 22, 1999

TEMPLE CITY, CA – Gaillard D. Dickinson, son of Norris "Ben" and Martha (Monkman) Dickinson, was born Aug. 4, 1919, in Harlan. He died Aug. 22, 1999, in Methodist Hospital Arcadia, CA. He attended school at Kirkman, graduating from there in 1937. He operated a garage and gas station in Kirkman until he entered the Army in June 1942. He served in the 4th Inf. Division in the D Day Invasion of Germany in WW II. He received his discharge from the service in April 1945.

July 1, 1943, he married Z. Clarine Vanderhoff of Sioux Rapids. To this union one daughter was born. After his discharge from the Army, he lived in Radcliffe and Estherville, until he and his family moved to Temple City, CA, where he was employed by the Temple City School District until he retired.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Norris Dickinson. He is survived by his wife, Clarine; a daughter, Elaine Frasca (Carlo); one grandson, Jeremy Frasca, all of Woodinville, WA; one sister, Darlene (Gilbert) Hanson of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Graveside services were held Aug. 26, 1999, with burial in Rose Hill Memorial Cemetery in Whittier, CA, with Rev. Danile Albarian officiating.
