

Virginia W. Dickinson, 78

May 19, 1920 – March 28, 1999

DUARTE, CA – Virginia W. Dickinson, the daughter of Clifford and Anna Jensen Potter, was born May 19, 1920, at Harlan. She was a member of the Bethel Baptist Church and graduated from the Harlan High School with the class of 1938.

March 7, 1940, she married Norris "Dick" Dickinson of Kirkman. Two children were born to this union. After their marriage they made their home in Kirkman until 1951, when they moved to Duarte, CA. Virginia was employed by the Duarte Unified Schools for 25 years until she retired. She died at her home March 28, 1999.
