

Donald "Fudd" Dollen, 64

Jan. 7, 1935 – Nov. 25, 1999

ABILENE, TX – Donald D. "Fudd" Dollen, 64, was born Jan. 7, 1935, son of Lowell and Verdene (Cave) Dollen, in Shenandoah, where the family resided then. They also lived in Chicago, IL, for a time where his father worked for the Erie Railroad and they also lived in Omaha. They returned to the family farm near Persia in 1947, and the family home in Persia in 1953. Don graduated from Persia High School in 1953. He served in the Army in the Korean War. He had worked for Bishop Office Machines in Omaha, was a salesman for Kaiser Industries for several years and worked part time at the Maxwell Golf Course. He was also a member of the American Legion. He died at the Abilene Regional Hospital, Abilene, TX, Nov. 25, 1999.

He is survived by one sister, Deanna Piatt of Bella Vista, AR; three brothers, Dick (Patsy) Dollen of Abilene, TX; Dennis Dollen of Harlan; and David Dollen of Crescent; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
