

Jessie Dworak, 97

July 27, 1902 – May 14, 2000

WALNUT – Jessie Pope Dworak was born July 27, 1902, in Walnut, daughter of James and Charlotte Drake Pope, and was one of seven children in the family. She graduated from the Walnut High School in 1920. Soon after graduation she moved to Omaha, NE.

Jessie married Arthur Dworak. She worked for many years in the clerical department at the University of Nebraska Hospital in Omaha. She was affiliated with the Presbyterian Church in Walnut. She died May 14, 2000, at Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic, at age 97 years, nine months and 17 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Arthur, and her son, Lloyd Carter, who was killed in WW II while he was a Navy pilot; her brothers and sisters, Addie Tilton, Beryl Claussen, Lottie Bunker, June Peterson, Everett Pope and Harvey Pope. She is survived by her nieces and nephews.
