

Joseph S. Fieldhouse, 93

Feb. 25, 1900 — June 8, 1993

HARLAN — Joseph Salway Fieldhouse, III, son of Joseph S. Fieldhouse, II and Lena was born Feb. 25, 1900 at Chester, PA. He grew to adulthood in PA., and in 1944, completed courses in Engineering Drafting I & II at Penn State College at Chester. In 1956, he attended Weaver School of Real Estate in Philadelphia, PA.

He lived and worked in the Philadelphia area as a tool maker, and in developing and experimental departments in General Electric, RCA and then Westinghouse. He retired in Feb. of 1965 and moved to West Palm Beach, FL. For the last two and one half years, he had made his home in Harlan, first with his niece, Lois Everson. Since Feb. 6, 1992, he had been a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home, and this was where he died June 8, 1993, at age 93 years, 3 months and 14 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife, Peg; and his second wife, Rose; and two sisters. He is survived by his niece, Lois Everson (Keith) of Harlan; 2 nephews; and 2 Godchildren.
