KIRKMAN — Ron Keith Fiscus, son of Keith and Bonnie (Fenster) Fiscus was born July 26, 1969 in Harlan. He grew up on his parents farm near Kirkman where he learned the many aspects of farming. He was baptized at the Irwin Church of Christ and attended preschool in Harlan and graduated from the Irwin-Kirkman School in 1988. While growing up on his parents farm, he became involved in 4-H which became a very important part of his life. He was a member of the Douglas Wise Owl's and later became a member of the Shelby County as well as the State 4-H Council. During high school he was also involved in many activities including sports, drama and speech.

After graduation, he attended Iowa State University and graduated in May of 1992. During the summers, he worked for the Farmer's Home Administration in the Denison office. Upon graduation, he returned to Kirkman and worked with his father on their farm. He was also a member of the First Baptist Church in Harlan. He died Nov. 28, 1992 in Harlan, at age 23 years, 4 months and 2 days.

He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Wayne Walter Fenster. He is survived by his parents, Keith and Bonnie of Kirkman; his grandparents, Ivan and Charlene Fiscus of Kirkman and Winnie Wilcox of Harlan; three uncles, Gary (Judy) Fenster of Co.
