## **Loretta Fisher, 89**

*Jan. 21, 1906 - April 19, 1995*

**Harlan** - Loretta Lucy Fisher, daughter of William and Nora (Gleason) Hilger was born Jan. 21, 1906 at Riverton. She was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Faith at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Hamburg and attended Riverton Public Schools.

In 1941 she married Eldon Fisher at Omaha. After their marriage, they farmed in the Red Oak area until 1958. After moving to Harlan she was employed in the Housekeeping Department of the Myrtue Memorial Hospital from Nov. 1967 to May of 1976. Aug. 29, 1994, she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home. It was there that she died April 19, 1995 at age 89 years, two months and 29 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brothers and sisters - Harold "Don", Paul, Lawrence and Dan Hilger and Mary Jean Johnson and Dorothy Lindberg. She is survived by her sister-in-law, Donna Hilger of Omaha and her nephews and nieces.
