

# Elvin Henry Foje, 80

December 20, 1914-May 19, 1995

**Logan** - Elvin Henry Foje, 80, was born Dec. 20, 1914 on a farm northwest of Persia, son of Ferdinand and Margretha (Martens) Foje. When he was 3 years, his mother died so he lived with relatives in Co. Bluffs for 3 years until his father remarried and he again lived near Persia.

March 22, 1938 he married Donna Grossner of Logan at Persia. He farmed and did custom work in the Persia area. Later he worked 20 years for Pacific Fruit Express in Co. Bluffs. The couple moved to Logan in 1984. He was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Persia and transferred to Immanuel Lutheran at Logan in 1986. He died May 19, 1995 at Logan.

He was preceded in death by his parents, stepmother, Anna, two infant brothers, one infant half-brother and one step brother, Arlo Koenig. Survivors are his wife Donna, son Vernon (Rose) of Jefferson, daughter Carol (Dewey) Brockmann of Co. Bluffs, four grandchildren, two great grandchildren, two half sisters, Dorothy (Howard) Darrington of Neola and Thelma (Harold) O'Neill of Logan, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
