Edward Henry Frederiksen, 89

March 19, 1906 - March 21, 1995

Kimballton - Edward Henry Frederiksen, son of Martin and Carrie Petersen Frederiksen, was born March 19, 1906 in Audubon County. He died March 21, 1995 at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan at age 89. He was baptized at his parents home, March 19, 1916, by the Rev. H. L. Jensen. He was confirmed at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton in 1921. He attended elementary school, and graduated from Elk Horn High School in 1926. After high school, he worked at various jobs. He had done farm work for many years for William Leistad, had formed a partnership with Elmer as carpenter and also worked for the Gearhart Lumber Company in Harlan for a number of years. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, until failing health prevented it.

June 1, 1955 he married Lucille Lauritsen in Co. Bluffs. They made their home in Kimballton. She died Nov. 15, 1986.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Lucille; two sisters, Anna Leistad and Alma Moreland and three brothers, William, Earnest and Elmer. Survivors include his brother, LaVern (Luella) of Elk Horn; several nieces, nephews, cousins and other relatives.

Funeral services were held March 24, 1995 at the Immanuel Lutheran Church, Kimballton with Pastor John Riggie and Pastor Stephen Gronseth officiating. Burial was in the Maple Grove cemetery, Audubon.
