

## **H.F. Fredrickson, 93** ✓

**ELK HORN** — H.F. Fredrickson was born April 15, 1898 in Clay twp., Shelby county, to John F. and Bentena (Hanson) Fredrickson. He attended rural schools in Shelby county and an automotive and electrical college in Kansas City.

Feb. 14, 1932, he married Mildred Nelson. Two children were born to this union, Roland LaRue and Faye Carol. They farmed in the Rorbeck area. Later he attended a television and radio repair school in Chicago. In 1963, they moved to Elk Horn where he engaged in the television and radio sales and repair. He died Dec. 2, 1991 at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn. He was a member of the Seventh Day Adventist Church of Atlantic.

Preceding him in death were his parents and two brothers, Edwin C. and Wilfred, who died as an infant. Survivors are his wife, Mildred of the Salem Retirement Home in Elk Horn; one son, Roland (Rose Marie) of Arvada, CO.; one daughter, Faye (Frank) Martin of Kansas City, KS.; two granddaughters; a brother, Emory (Edna) of Elk Horn; and numerous nieces and nephews.
