

## **Grace Lucile Faaborg, 89**

*Sept. 22, 1909 - March 3, 1999*

**DANVILLE** - Grace Lucile Faaborg was born Sept. 22, 1909, in Mondamin, the daughter of William Leslie and Evaline Morrow Stuart.

Feb. 10, 1931, she married Simon Edward Faaborg in Audubon, who died Nov. 24, 1969. She was a graduate of Audubon High School. She resided in Kimballton from 1931 to 1975, and during that time she gave piano lessons, was the town librarian, was an operator at the telephone office, was a bookkeeper/secretary at the Kimballton Sale Barn, was the manager of the movie theater, ran a cafe with her husband, Simon, was a professional sign painter, and was secretary of the Kimballton School Board for a number of years. For the past 23 years, she made her home in Danville, near her son, Phil. She became a resident of Danville Care Center four years before her death, when she developed Alzheimer's disease. She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in West Burlington, and a former member of Burlington Professional Women's Association. She died March 3, 1999, at Danville Care Center at age 89.

Preceding her in death besides her husband were her parents and one sister. Surviving are a son, Phil Faaborg of Dallas City, IL; three grandchildren; a brother, Bob Stuart of Boring, OH; and four sisters, Sister Mary Wilma "Florence" Stuart and Sister Mary Mauricita "Mary" Stuart, both of Dubuque; Margaret Bintner of Lee's Summit, MO; and Louise Bintner of Seal Beach, CA.

Funeral services were conducted March 6, 1999, at Luning Chapel with Rev. Gerald Stouvenel officiating. Burial was the following day at Immanuel Lutheran Cemetery in Kimballton.
