WOODBINE – Darrell M. Fahrenkrog was born May 17, 1926, the son of Monroe and Mary (Gerratt) Fahrenkrog, near Persia. He attended school in Persia. He was baptized and confirmed at St. John's Lutheran Church in Persia, and was a member of the First Methodist Church in Woodbine, since moving there about five years ago.

He married Jean Whitmore June 4, 1947, at the Christian Church in Logan, and they farmed the family farm until 1997. They were the parents of one daughter, Vicki. Jean died Aug. 24, 2000.

Aug. 11, 2001, he married JoAnn Thomsen at the Sacred Heart Church in Woodbine. He died Nov. 12, 2001, at Osceola, MO, while on a bus tour at age 75.
