Sadie Fascher, 93

Oct. 3, 1911 - Nov. 16, 2004

WILMINGTON, NC — Sadie Garnett Fascher was born in Oklahoma Oct. 3, 1911, and grew up in Manilla. She later moved to Harlan where she spent most of her adult life. She was a school teacher for many years, and taught country school in a one-room schoolhouse, teaching students in grades 1 through 8. She was an active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan. Sadie moved to Wilmington, NC, in 1997 to be near her family. She resided at the Catherine Kennedy Home until its closure and then moved to Lakeshore Commons Retirement Home. She was an associate member of Trinity United Methodist Church. She died Nov. 15, 2004, at the Lower Cape Fear Hospice Center in Wilmington, at age 93.

Sadie was preceded in death by her husband, Art; a twin sister, Goldie; an older sister, Mary; and three brothers, George, Garth and Freddie. She is survived by her son, Ron Fascher (Pat); her daughter, Sandy Fascher; her grandson, David Fascher (Lori); and great-grandson, Colson Fascher; and grandson, Marc Fascher, all of Wilmington, NC.

A memorial service was held at Lakeshore Commons Retirement Home on Hospital Plaza Drive Nov. 21, 2004, with Rev. Bill Cottingham officiating. Burial of the cremains will be held at the Harlan Cemetery at a later date.
