

Inez P. Fink, 81

Aug. 3, 1919 - March 12, 2001

HARLAN – Inez Pauline Fink, daughter of Theodore and Augusta Vanderhide Ohlquist, was born Aug. 3, 1919, on a farm near Wakefield, NE. She attended high school at a rural school in Dixon County.

She married William Charles Fink Oct. 15, 1937, at Papillion, NE. After marriage, they lived in Coldridge and Randolph, NE areas where Bill farmed. In 1948, they moved to a farm near Kirkman, where Bill farmed. In 1960, they moved into Kirkman. In 1975, they moved to Harlan. Inez worked at the pork plant from 1960 to 1962. She then went to work at the Baptist Memorial Home until she retired in 1989. She died March 12, 2001, at her home in Harlan, at age 81 years, seven months and nine days.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her mother and father and her brother, Alvin Ohlquist.
