March 28, 1918 - March 3, 2003

HARLAN – Charline Ione Fiscus was born March 28, 1918, in Shelby County, the daughter of Ira and Lillian Vincent Miller. She attended country school and graduated from Kirkman High School with the class of 1937.

She married Ivan Fiscus Oct. 10, 1940, in Omaha, NE, and to this union one son was born, Keith Ivan Fiscus. They lived and farmed in the Shelby County area all their married life. Ivan and Charline had celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary in October of 2002. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Harlan. Charline died March 3, 2003, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 84 years, 11 months and six days.
