Atlantic - Lotia Vallie Dent Fiscus was born Feb. 21, 1906 in Douglas Township, Audubon County, the fifth child of Robert Daniel and Maggie Elizabeth Duling Dent. At the age of seven days, she and her family moved to Shelby County, where she grew up and attended school. She attended the Redline Church of Christ and was baptized there as a young lady.

Feb. 3, 1926 she married John Kenneth Fiscus. They helped operate the family ranch until 1937, when they moved to California. One child, Linda Lee, was born to the couple in 1938. After relocating to Omaha in 1944, they operated their own business until 1947 when John died from cancer. In 1950 she and Linda moved to Shelby County, where she lived and operated a restaurant business in partnership with her sister until 1968. At that time she accepted a position with the Linn County Care Facility Administrative Office in Marion. After heart surgery in 1978, she continued to live in her home until 1982. She then moved to Atlantic where she has made her home with her daughter and son-in-law until the present time. She resided at the Atlantic Care and Rehabilitation Center since January of this year, where she died June 1, 1997.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, John; brothers Gordon, Glen and Boyd Dent; sisters Doris Tague, Faye McCord McNeighan and Lovie Fiscus. She is survived by her daughter and husband, Linda L. (Gayle L.) Campbell of Atlantic; grandson Timothy J. Campbell of Branson, MO; granddaughter and husband Tracy J. (Jeff) Martin of Atlantic; great-grandsons Andrew J. Martin, of Atlantic and Blaine Campbell of Branson, MO, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
