ELK HORN — Edith Hansen was born Feb. 8, 1911 in Sharon twp. in Audubon co., to Chris and Marie Boll Sorensen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton. She was currently a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran Church.

Feb. 14, 1929, she married Clarence Hansen. They lived on Clarence's home place southeast of Elk Horn until 1970. In 1971 they moved to Elk Horn. After Clarence died in Jan. of 1987, she continued to live in their home in Elk Horn. She died Jan. 17, 1991 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan after having been in the hospital only a few days. She was active in her social country club, the women's church circle, and Alpha Ladies Aid.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, Clarence; one daughter, Sandra Bierbaum, and one brother, Victor Sorensen. She is survived by one son, Richard Hansen of Boone; one daughter, Rose Marie Jensen of Tyler, MN.; 10 grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren, and one sister, Aletha Sorensen of Laguna Hills, CA.

Funeral services were held Jan. 21, 1991, in the Elk Horn Lutheran Church with Pastor Michael Williams, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn Lutheran cemetery.
